TENTATIVE ITINERARY

<u>Friday, October 11</u>

Land in Prague late this evening and transfer to the <u>Holiday Inn Prague</u>.

<u>Saturday, October 12</u>

Today join a private walking tour in the city center with a welcome group dinner this evening.

<u>Sunday, October 13 - Tuesday, October 15</u>

Attend sessions at the Forum 2000 conference. Since the beginning, the aim of the Forum 2000 Conferences was to map the globalization process and to note its positive results as well as the perils encountered by an increasingly volatile, accelerated and interconnected world. It has always striven to maintain an up-todate dialogue about important and complex issues that are key to the future of civilization. The current discussions at the Conference explore and analyze the democracy and human rights developments around the world, the rise of authoritarianism and illiberalism, the impact of technology on society, the competition for global tech dominance, the global cooperation of democracies, and the role of civil society, among other topics and specific themes.

The Forum 2000 delegates also discuss how to handle the global variety of cultures, ideologies and religions; how to strengthen and promote the liberal order as an answer at the global level; and what the role of the media and the big tech companies (mostly related to information and social media) is in the conflict of perceptions.

The goal of these discussions is to achieve a better understanding of our globalized and uncertain world and of the key challenges facing mankind.

Forum 2000 provides global political, intellectual, spiritual, and business leaders with the proper venue to voice their concerns as well as to look for ways to address them.

<u>Wednesday, October 16</u>

Today we will allow time to visit cultural landmarks in Prague including the Karlstejn Castle, founded in 1348 by King Charles IV. We will look to arrange a U.S. Embassy briefing along with Radio Free Europe. This evening attend a final group farewll dinner.

<u>Thursday, October 17</u>

Depart for the U.S. or remain in Prague for additional sightseeing.
